<b>Admission requirements for Application</b>	-To be enrolled in the first year in the Economics MSc course -Level C1 certified knowledge of the English language
<b>Call for application</b>	Call for application and selection take place usually in March
<b>Selection of candidates</b>	Students will be selected on the basis of the following criteria: -personal statement; -Curriculum Vitae; -language competence; -university career to date, credits and grades obtained in the first semester; -individual interview
<b>Admission requirement</b>	Selected students must have completed all university credits as provided in their 1st year study plan before the start of courses at the host University. Students who fail to meet this requirement by the deadline will be assessed by the relevant Teaching Committee.
<b>Dissertation defense</b>	The dissertation defence will take place at both Institutions in accordance with the teaching regulations of each university. If students do not defend the dissertation within the legal term of the academic year of the Host Institution, they will have to be enrolled in the following year and pay the relevant tuition fees.
<b>Tuition cost</b>	Students will be required to renew the enrollment and pay tuition to their home institution during the exchange period. Students may receive the scholarship from their home institution according to its policies
